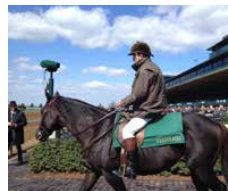

"The Rhone's Chateauneuf du Pape has been one of the hottest categories of the new millennium in the American market, thanks in equal part to the nearly candied ripeness and full-bodied, chewy texture of these wines and to an unprecedented string of four consecutive very good to outstanding vintages between 1998 and 2001. Chateauneuf du Pape comes in a variety of styles, from restrained midweights to extravagantly rich, roasted, low-acid head-spinners with alcohol commonly in the 15+% range. The most rabid buying interest is concentrated on the latter category. Look for bold, liqueur-like aromas and flavors of cherry and raspberry complicated by game, leather, chocolate, earth, and roasted herbs and spices; lush, tactile mouth feel; and ripe, sweet tannins."

"Although 13 grape varieties, including five white grapes, are permitted to go into Chateauneuf blends, the typical wine is based on 75% to 80% Grenache, a classic hot-climate grape that produces robust, full-bodied wines with high alcohol, low acidity, and a tendency to oxidize quickly. Small but increasing percentages of Syrah and Mourvedre are frequently included to add color, aromatic complexity, spiciness, acidity, and structure."

Your blood pressure will drop 10 points as you rumble across the covered bridge, another 10 as you approach the Campton Farm Stand and see the White Mountain Range laid out before you, and 30 points more as you step inside and experience the warmth and charm of this extraordinary home. Rich with hand-hewn beams inside and out (imagine a giant wooden honeycomb), this is not Abe Lincoln's log cabin. But neither is it a log McMansion. Rather, this hand-hewn wood home, Thumper's Lair, is as close as you'll come to a combination of authentic log cabin and modern conveniences.

Activities at the cabin abound year-round. You're 12 minutes from Waterville Valley Ski Resort and 20 from Loon Mountain. Canoe and kayak rentals are two miles away. You're surrounded by miles and miles of stunning mountain trails (one that runs along the striking Mad River is right outside your door). Birds and wildlife are abundant. And, of course, the October leaves are ineffably beautiful. But cabin life is equally enchanting. You can grill steak and veggies on the wrap around deck, create your own culinary magic in the well-appointed cook's kitchen, and roast marshmallows in the fire-pit. You can sit on the deck with a drink and listen to the river race over the rocks. Or you can simply sit and read in the vaulted-ceiling living room, in front of the floor-to-ceiling stone fireplace, and

let the seven-foot, windowed doors bring nature indoors to you. And if it rains (or if you need a break from all that nature and relaxation!), you can ride the beautiful Kancamagus Highway, "The Kanc," as it's known to the locals, to the fabled North Conway Outlet Malls. Or hang out with the local folk at Mad River Tavern. **Whatever you do, one thing is certain:** You will never forget this place or the time you spend there. It is truly a place of sanctuary.

Practical Notes: The cabin is located in Campton, NH, about two hours north of Boston via Interstate 93. It has approximately 2100 square feet on three levels and sleeps six guests easily and comfortably in its three bedrooms. There are two full bathrooms. It doesn't have a telephone (cell phone service is excellent), and the cabin is not handicap accessible. Snow plowing and caretaking are prearranged for your convenience.

In 1989 and 1990 Giacosa produced an immense number of legendary wines. In fact, he is one of the very few producers who did exceptionally well in both years. In general the 1989s are a touch more layered and nuanced, while the 1990s are impressive for their massive concentration. If forced to state a preference, I would say 1990 gets the nod for its consistency from top to bottom."

Antonio Galloni says..."Bruno Giacosa's wines are well represented in my personal cellar, which was the source for the vast majority of these bottles. I have had the good fortune to taste all of Giacosa's 1989s and 1990s from multiple sources over the last year, and therefore can report that these notes are representative of what readers can expect from well-stored bottles. The official tasting of his wine is performed with the ceremonial precision and religious intensity of a First Communion."

Cantina Bartolo Mascarello - Private visit with Maria-Teresa Mascarello, the winemaker and owner. "In 1990, Italy's Noble Red Wines author Sheldon Wasserman called Bartolo Mascarello's hand-crafted Barolo "the single finest Barolo made." And in the years before his death, Bartolo was still considered a touchstone for those who prize the beauty of traditionally made Barolo. Today, it is the wine world's great fortune that Bartolo's daughter Maria Teresa—who took over Cantina Bartolo Mascarello in 2005—makes wine just as her father did. In fact, she is every bit as committed to her family's methods and traditions as Bartolo was. And she may have brought even greater elegance and consistency to the wines through her own subtle refinements.



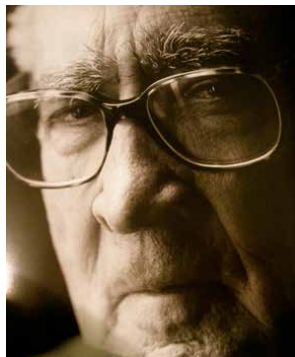
G.B. Burlotto - Private visit to the cellars and tasting of Barolo with fourth generation winemaker, Fabio Alessandria. Your visit will also include lunch for four. A century ago, the Burlotto family towered over Barolo in the same way that Biondi-Santi did in Tuscany, or Vega Sicilia did in Spain. After the 1927 death of its founder, G.B. Burlotto, the house faded into obscurity, but it is now back in the spotlight, thanks to the brilliant winemaking of G.B.'s great-great-grandson, Fabio Alessandria. Fabio's winemaking is throwback to earlier days, and he is one of the few remaining winemakers in Piedmont to still crush grapes by foot. Today, many insiders consider Fabio's Barolo Monvigliero among the transcendent wines of Barolo.

Today, Mauro Mascarello is the last remaining giant of the great Barolo generation that included Giovanni Conterno and Bartolo Mascarello. Mauro has been the winemaker for the Giuseppe Mascarello estate since the late 1960s, succeeding his father, Giuseppe, and his grandfather, Maurizio, both legends in their time. And like them, Mauro is a traditionalist dedicated to long fermentations and aging in massive old barrels. "Mauro makes some of the most compelling, traditional wines in Piedmont." Antonio Galloni

Bruno Giacosa - Private visit to the winery and tasting with Bruno Giacosa's daughter, Bruna, who today manages the estate. A TRIP BACK IN TIME: AN UNFORGETTABLE WINE JOURNEY FOR FOUR TO MADEIRA

On a 1950 visit to Madeira, Sir Winston Churchill was honored by the island's British community with a dinner party. As a special tribute, his hosts opened a rare 1792 vintage Madeira bottled in 1840. When served in 1950, the wine was 158 years old, but in fine condition, still boasting Madeira's trademark rich, sweet, velvety taste and room filling aromas of butterscotch, cocoa and coffee. Sir Winston insisted on serving the guests himself, asking each in turn, "Do you realize that when this wine was vintaged Marie Antoinette was alive?"

Madeira's longevity earns it a special place in the realm of old wine. What other wine requires over a half century to mature? And what other wine, when a century old, still benefits from several hours of breathing and can stand up to weeks in a decanter, without losing its complexity or its richness? And how many wines can live for two centuries and still offer not only the pleasure of their antiquity, but also the enjoyment of drinking?

Of the hundreds of families who've produced and shipped Madeira over the past two centuries, few remain, including Blandy's, Borges, D'Oliveira and Barbeito.

The first three of these are proud survivors from the 19th century--their legacy secured by having stockpiled old vintages during and after the Phylloxera epidemic of the 1870s. Barbeito is much younger, having been founded in 1946, but its legacy of old wines is as rich as the other houses.

Enjoy a winery visit to Barbeito and an extensive tasting with winemaker, Ricardo Freitas. Ricardo has married a deep respect for Madeira's roots with profound energy and innovation. His work, and his wines, have been crucial in restoring the world's appreciation for Madeira. Your visit includes choice of lunch or dinner with Ricardo.

D'Oliveira is one of the greatest of the classic Madeira shippers, and one of the few to survive from the pre-phylloxera era. Pingus

While other Spanish wines have achieved international recognition, Pingus is one of the very few that has joined the ranks of the world's most coveted wines and is known and admired wherever great wine is discussed.

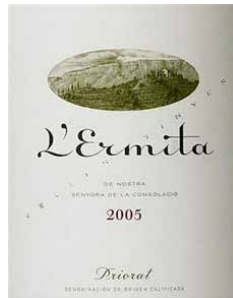

Alvaro Palacios

If anyone embodies the promise and spirit of "The New Spain," it's Alvaro Palacios. His L'Ermita is widely considered—along with Peter Sisseck's Pingus—to be the most important Spanish wine of the modern era. His contributions to Spanish winemaking have been so great that he was named Decanter magazine's Man of the Year for 2015.

One of nine children born to the owners of Rioja's respected Palacios Remondo, Alvaro studied enology in Bordeaux, while working under Jean-Pierre Moueix at Chateau Pétrus. He credits his tenure at Pétrus for much of his winemaking philosophy and for showing him "the importance of great wines."

In the 1980s, Alvaro was drawn to the largely abandoned, ancient vineyards of Priorat. Located 60 miles from Barcelona,

Priorat had been one of Spain's important pre-Phylloxera wine regions. And with its unique terroir of steep hills and terraces, Alvaro believed he could make wines that rivaled the best of Europe.

He acquired his first vineyard, Finca Dofi, in 1990. Then, in 1993, he located what is now regarded as the crown jewel property in Priorat, a precipitous, northeast-facing Garnacha vineyard on well-drained schist that had been planted between 1900 and 1940. Alvaro named it for a small chapel, or hermitage, that sits atop the hill. Today, L'Ermita sells for upwards of \$1000 a bottle.

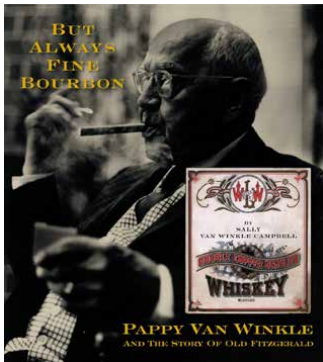

Château Haut Brion 1995 (10 bottles)

"It is fun to go back and forth between the 1995 and 1996, two superb vintages for Haut-Brion. The 1995 seems to have sweeter tannin and a bit more fat and seamlessness when compared to the more structured and muscular 1996. Certainly 1995 was a vintage that the brilliant administrator Jean Delmas handled flawlessly. The result is a deep ruby/purple-colored wine with a tight but promising nose of burning wood embers intermixed with vanilla, spice box, earth, mineral, sweet cherry, black currant, plum-like fruit, medium to full body, a high level of ripe but sweet tannin, and a finish that goes on for a good 40-45 seconds." Anticipated maturity: 2006-2035. **WA 96**

Château La Mission Haut Brion 1995 (4 bottles)

"This vintage is aging at a glacial pace and the tannins are currently more significant than their counterbalancing components of fruit and glycerin. As in most 1995s, the color remains a healthy dark plum/purple. One of the bigger wines of the vintage, the ripe, powerful Merlot component has buttressed the Cabernet elements, giving the wine plenty of body, tannin and La Mission's classic asphalt, cassis, blackberry, smoky barbecue, meaty notes intermixed with a hint of hot rocks." Anticipated maturity: 2020-2035?. **WA 95+**

Château Mouton Rothschild 1995 (17 bottles)

"This wine is evolving into one of Mouton-Rothschild's greatest vintages. It boasts an inky purple color, as well as a powerful, blockbuster nose of explosively jammy cassis intermingled with toasty new oak, minerals, and spice. The wine is layered, with extraordinary depth, richness, glycerin, and length. This is undoubtedly the greatest Mouton since the 1986, with a more precocious, up-front character than that wine. A formidable tannin level combined with low acidity, and magnificent layers of fruit suggest the 1995 will be approachable after bottling, but I expect it to close down (as most Mouton-Rothschilds do) after 6-7 years in the bottle, not to re-emerge for 15-20 years." Anticipated maturity: 2005-2030. **WA 97**

Château Lafite Rothschild 1995 (11 bottles)

"This dark purple-colored 1995 displays the quintessentially elegant Lafite style in both the aromatics and flavors. Subtle lead pencil, black currant, and cedary notes emerge from the wine's bouquet with coaxing. In the mouth, it is beautifully knit, medium-bodied, suave, and elegant, with no intention of being flamboyant and/or over-sized. This is a textbook, classic Lafite-Rothschild that should reward 10-20 years of cellaring." Anticipated maturity: 2008-2035. **WA 95**
